Defibrillator now at School

A big THANK YOU to the Wilmington Op Shop for donating the money for the school to buy a defibrillator. A **defibrillator** is a device that uses electricity to re-start the heart or shock it back into its correct rhythm. It is used when someone has a sudden cardiac arrest. This is when the heart suddenly stops pumping. The **defibrillator** analyses the heart rhythm and decides whether an electric shock is needed. Hopefully we will never have to use it. It will be stored in the purpose built cabinet on the wall outside the staff room by the roller door where it is out of the weather but easily accessible by the school and the swimming pool attendants if ever needed. In an emergency the public is welcome to access it as well.
